- We developed a unique global online reporting system called GCARS Global cabin Air Reporting System. GCARS for the first time enables data to be globally collected and analysed. gcars.app
- We led the way in developing the extensive medical protocol for those exposed to contaminated air and which is now published in a medical journal.
